comp	ire a basset certification to be able to serve. <u>ALL individuals serving alcohol are required to</u> lete this and must be 21 years old. Go to www.illinoisbassetcertification.com to complete the ir course. Fees apply.
Acqu	ire the appropriate liability insurance from your current insurance agency.
